#### Old Business:

AA Space: the new room has been cleaned out and they are currently painting. (After council meeting Sherri checked with them and they just finished and will be moving their tables, etc. soon)

Payment for repair to the sanctuary: Paid in full: special funds, the Memorials of Cliff Olsson, Linda Hultquist, and Marge Hanson. (Please note: Simmons gave us a 10% discount on the final bill due to the time frame and extent of the project) Thank you for that!

#### **New Business:**

M/S/C by Mike Linch and Pastor Evan to have December Benevolence directed to the local AA Chapter M/S/C by Raquel Linch and Deb Pantini to have January Benevolence go to the Food Pantry Conference Dean Approval Abundant Field Conference: M/S/C by Jewel Basely and Raquel Linch to adopt as written. (See attached sheet)

M/S/C by Mike Linch and Raquel Linch to set the annual meeting for February 11 with February 18 being the snow date.

2024 Budget: Finance made note that the budget will be similar to 2023 and adding \$2,000 to Pastor's base salary of \$14,400 (from general) \$10,000 housing (from endowment) M/S/C by Sherri Nissen and Jewel Basely to approve the 2024 budget

Checking Accounts: The account from PSCB has been moved to Iowa State Savings Bank allowing only one bank stop vs two.

M/S/C by Mike Linch and Raquel Linch to move the Youth Checking Account to Special Funds with their own line item.

Christmas Offering: M/S/C by Jewel Basely and Sherri Nissen for the Osceola Aid Water Emergency Fund.

#### Committee Reports:

Christian Education: We had good adult participation in the Christmas program, and it was well received. Church Property: Work on the sanctuary is completed. Assisting AA in moving furniture. We will be advertising on area SWAP pages the Ping Pong Table and Air Hockey Table for a donation, if we still have them, they will be put on the women's sale.

Outreach Ministry: Delivered gifts to Homestead Assisted Living Dec. 11. We had six residents each receiving 2 gifts each. Thank you to everyone who made this possible. We will be helping at the Food Pantry January 21 at 12:00pm. There is a sign-up sheet in the Narthex.

Worship & Music: has been planning holiday/advent services through January 7. The choir meets on Wednesday evenings and has been going well. Thank you, Sheila and others, for this blessing.

Finance: the proposed 2024 budget is being presented to council for approval

Memorial Committee: no meeting, but via phone calls approved use of various funds for the sanctuary repair.

Memorial funds earmarked for the organ of \$3,044.28 have been reimbursed to the endowment fund.

(When organ repair was completed, it was paid for with endowment funds)


